




#### Q2 Do you have any grandchildren?



#### Q3 What is your age?





## Q4 How long have you been a part of Believers Fellowship?





# Q5 How well would you say that you "belong" at Believers Fellowship (like you feel at home at the church)?








## Q9 In church activities, how much meaningful contact do you have with people of another generation?



Q10 In what kinds of church activities do you come into contact with people of another generation? (Check all that apply.)





# Q11 How well would you say you identify with the musicians at Believers Fellowship (Walker Sherman and the band)?





# Q12 How well would you say you identify with the teachers at Believers Fellowship (Matt Edwards and Gary Albert)?





### Q13 How well would you say you identify with the elders at Believers Fellowship?













## Q19 Have you ever felt powerless to affect change at Believers Fellowship?



# Q20 When changes are made, how well do you feel that people like you are considered in the decision-making process?


