



God Protects Baby Moses

Exodus 1:22, 2:1-10

Parents,

This is a fun lesson to include water play (weather depending.) If possible: fill a tub outside and let your kids search for things that float. If the weather is not right for being outside, let them play in the sink or bathtub. Say: **“Today’s lesson is about how God protected a baby who floated down the river in a basket.”** After water play you can bring them to a table to teach the lesson.

LESSON

Say: **“There are lots of stories about Moses in the Bible. God has been watching over him ever since he was a baby. Did you know he was put in a basket and floated down the river? Let’s read the story and find out why. . . “**

Read from the Beginners Bible “A Basket Boat” or the story of Baby Moses in any Children’s Bible. If you don’t have a children’s Bible you can find these stories on YouTube.

Ask **“Why did the mother put her baby in the water? Was she scared that something bad would happen to him? Who did she ask to protect babe Moses? Did He? Yes! God made sure that Moses was found safely and raised to be the leader he was meant to be. God cared for Moses his whole life and God will always be with us. Let’s say our Bible Verse.”**

Bible Verse!

“God cares for you.” 1 Peter 5:7

Pray!

Dear God, thank you for taking care of baby Moses. Thank you for taking care of us, too! Amen

Craft!

Cut out the template of a baby and blanket. Let your child color them. Using a cupcake wrapper as a basket, have them put their baby and blanket in the basket. On a separate piece of paper, draw a river. *Even more fun* - use a blue sheet or blanket as a river. Let them tell you the story using their craft! This is a great way to reinforce the lesson.
