by Tony Merida

Although Ephesians is one of the New Testament's shortest books in terms of word count—only 6 chapters and 155 verses—it is perhaps the most applicable to today's culture. In addition to the divine beauty and power of Ephesians, this epistle also provides Paul's most direct address about the life of a disciple of Jesus. Paul conveyed his pastoral heart for the Ephesian believers by focusing on who they were in Christ. Specifically, he addressed issues related to their new life, the community of believers, the pursuits of unity and holiness, and life's challenges. Therefore, the book of Ephesians and this study offer practical answers to contemporary believers' basic questions about the Christian life and our identity in Christ.
